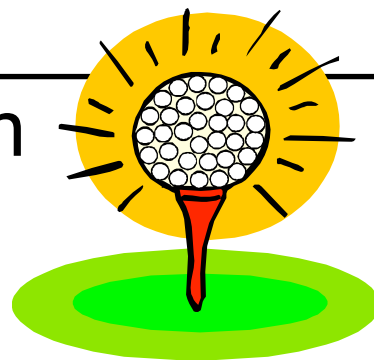

Registration for 2010

Registration for The First Tee of Sharon golf lessons for the 2010 sessions are as follows:

Early Registration will be April 17, 2010
2-4 PM
Regular registration is on May 1, 2010
from 10-Noon

Bring your child's report card in to take part in our Honor Roll Program for 2010 spring session. They will receive a frame able certificate from our National office.

The registration will take place at The First Tee of Sharon facility at Buhl Farm Golf Course.

The registration fee is \$15 per golfer, \$25 for a family of 2, and \$35 for a family of 3 or more for each class taken (Max. of 2 per season). This must be paid when registering.

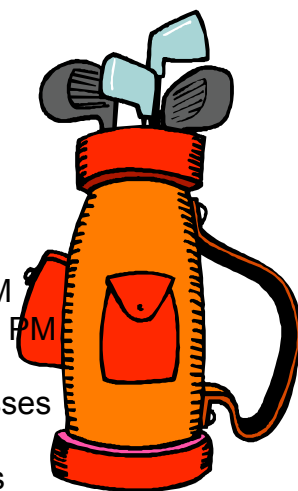

1. Honor Roll Program -- bring in report card to participate
2. Players Academy at Richmond, VA -- invite only

3. Scholar's Program -- for high school juniors and seniors
4. Future Leader's Forum -- potential futures in the golf industry (HS level)
5. Jr. Golf League --10 and older, Selected Wednesdays in June/July, Birdie level and up. Sign up and \$10 league dues required.
6. Mentor program -- students who exit Eagle level and become junior coaches to help with classes.

Levels of golf for The First Tee of Sharon

PLAYERS -- required for all new golfers . It is designed to learn basic golf through games , drills, and play. Attendance is required. This level is by ages - 7-8, 9-11,12 and up. (7-8 yrs will take 3 levels, 9-11yrs takes 2 levels , and 12+ takes 1 level.)

Par 1-2-3-- this level is broken down by ages -- 8-11,12 and up. It addresses golf skills at a basic level, interpersonal skills and self-improvement management skills. In Attendance is required. In each level certification testing will be required. (Golf rules and Life Skill written tests, putting test, chipping and pitching, fairways test, full swings, and 1 round of golf.)

Birdie 1-2-3 --this level builds on life skills which help young people to make and attain goals for success. Attendance is required. Certification testing is also required in each level. ((Golf rules and Life Skill written tests, putting test, chipping and pitching, fairways test, full swings, and 5 rounds of golf.)

Eagle I -2-3 --this level reinforces the Par and Birdie levels and addresses intermediate and advance golf skills, appreciating diversity, team building, and wellness for life. In Eagle 1 and 2 attendance is required. Certification testing is required in all levels. ((Golf rules and Life Skill written tests, putting test, chipping and pitching, fairways test, full swings, and 10 rounds of golf.)
